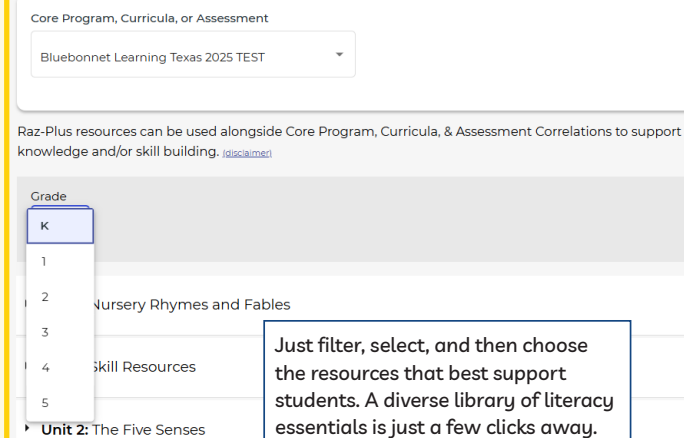

INDEPENDENT PRACTICE

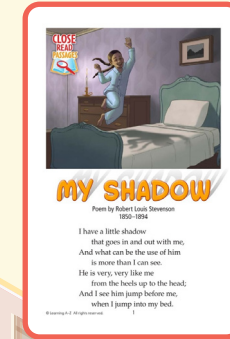
