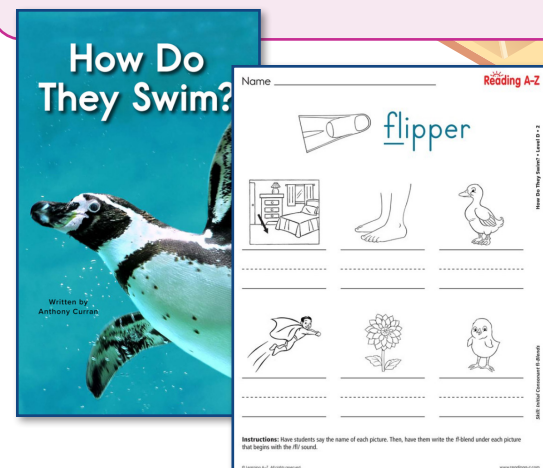

Independent Practice

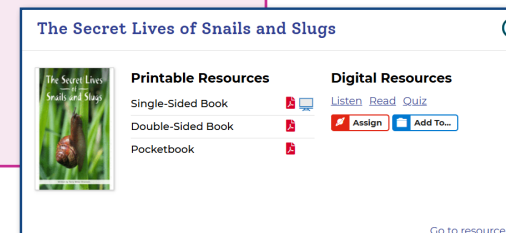

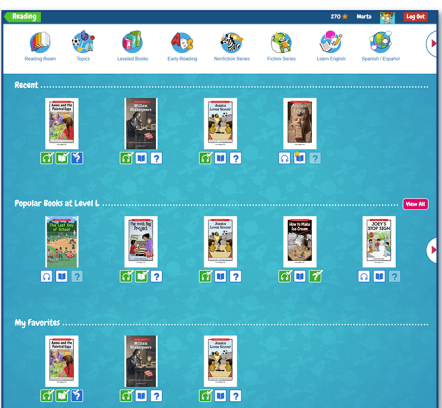
MORE Resources for Small Groups and Learning Centers

MORE Opportunities for Independent Practice

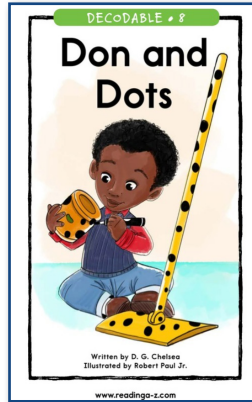

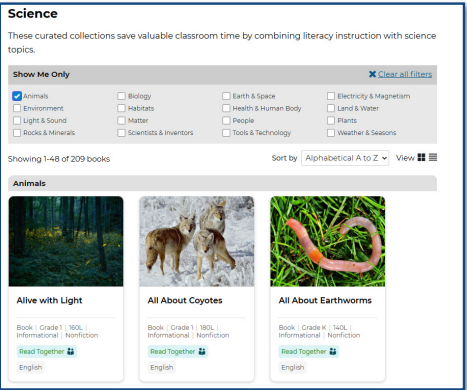
MORE Decodable Texts
