WHOLE-GROUP INSTRUCTION

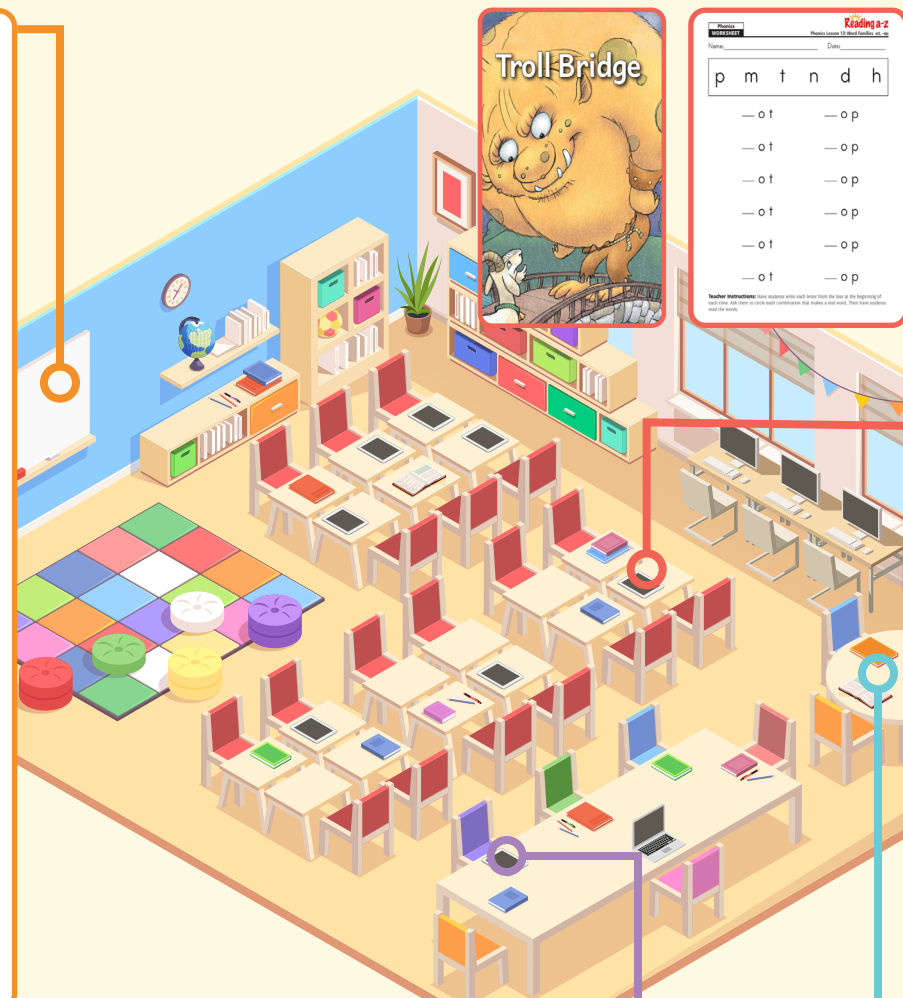

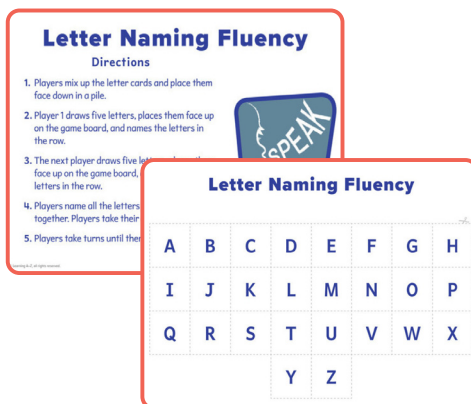
More knowledge-building support
